STUDENT RECYCLING PROGRESS

Middle Level

- November 26 – January 25:
 - 17.11lbs of batteries
 - 312 markers
- Total for ML from Fall until Jan. 25:
 - 48lbs of batteries
 - 641 markers

Upper Level

- Since Fall of 2018:
 - 41.292lbs of batteries
 - 347 markers



GREEN TIP

- What **CAN** and **CANNOT** be recycled in the single stream containers?
 - Paper (cardboard, magazines, junk mail, brown paper bags, newspapers, phone books, etc.)
 - Plastic (clean jugs, bottles)
 - Glass (bottles and jars)
 - Cans (aluminum, steel, empty aerosol cans)
 - Foil and pie tins (clean)



No plastic bags, plastic tubs, garbage, or food containers with garbage in them.
