Directions


Beltway, I-695 to Exit 29, Cromwell Bridge Rd. At the traffic light at the end of the exit ramp, turn LEFT (East) onto Cromwell Bridge Rd. Continue on Cromwell Bridge Rd past Loch Raven High School.

The 1st entrance to the Park is Sherwood Farm. Do NOT turn into the Sherwood Farm entrance!

Go $\frac{1}{2}$ mile past the Sherwood Farm entrance to the <u> 2^{nd} entrance, Willow Grove Farm</u>.

Turn LEFT into the driveway and continue across the bridge to the gravel parking lot.

Please wait for Staff instructions <u>BUSES</u> - DO NOT PARK ON THE GRASS!



Program Information Registration begins January 8 for programs scheduled for April 2 to May 30. Registration begins August 6 for programs scheduled for September 17 to November 19. There is no cost for field trips. [°] Field Trips are LIMITED to 40 students and with a minimum of 12 students. Please do not bring siblings. Capacity is limited. ^o Teachers and chaperones are expected to be fully involved in the program and MUST provide oversight. ° All Field Trip requests MUST be submitted using our Program Request Form. We highly encourage you to contact us prior with any questions. [°] A confirmation will be sent by email. Please review it carefully to avoid scheduling errors. ° School program requests are limited to 2 trips per season, Tuesday through Thursday. ° Weekday Pre K & K programs are 1 hour in length,

with the exception of Fall Harvest, which is an hour and a half.

 $^\circ$ All other school age group programs are 2 hours in length from 10 AM to 12 PM.

° Scout program requests are limited to 2 per season, Saturday & Sunday, 1 hr. in length.

° Wear clothes and shoes that can get wet/dirty. ° Port-a-pots are available.

° Please no tour buses as we can't accommodate such large buses.

- <u>Kinder Nature (SF)</u>. *1 Hour– Pre-K & K* Explore a seasonal topic with a Naturalist.
- <u>Outdoor Living Skills (SF)</u>. *Grades 2 and up*. Learn how to make fire, build shelter, and other survival skills.
- <u>Colonial Life at Fort Garrison (F)</u>. *Grades 2 and up.* Who were the Rangers stationed at the old Fort in 1693? Emphasis is on skills, tools and 17th century history. (OFFSITE at Fort Garrison in Pikesville.)
- <u>Reptiles & Amphibians (SF)</u>. Snakes, turtles and frogs have fascinating lives. Hike with us to look for and observe them.
- <u>Geology of Maryland (SF)</u>. Rocks and the minerals within them are like cookies which have ingredients. We'll hike to discover & collect specimens.



- <u>Hike into History (SF)</u>. *Grades 2 and up*. Hike to the log cabin and lime kilns to learn about life in Cromwell Valley 160 years ago. Try your hand at some of the things they did back then.
- <u>The Native Americans of Maryland (SF)</u>. What was life like for Native Americans before Europeans arrived? Learn by doing some of the things they did daily.
- <u>Habitat Explorers</u> (SF). All animals need food, water, shelter, and living space. Learn how animals have adapted to thrive in their habitats.
- <u>Stream Strollers (</u>SF). How does the health of our stream affect the health of the Chesa-peake Bay? Wade in with us to catch the crit-ters that live there. Water shoes/boots are a MUST.

- <u>Discovering Insects</u> (Late S & Early F). Explore the park's diverse insect life. Collect and observe insects. Learn about their life cycles and behavior.
- <u>"Tree"mendous Trees (</u>SF). All living things, including us, depend on trees. Hike and identify trees by their shape, leaves, branching, smell, taste, bark, fruit, and seeds.
- <u>Spring Planting</u> (S). *90 mins– Pre-K & K*. Learn how plants grow & why farms are important and then plant a sunflower seed to take home.
- <u>Fall Harvest (</u>F). *90 mins– Pre-K & K.* What was it like to live on Willow Grove Farm 160 years ago? Join in the harvest as we learn about the crops we harvest in the Fall.
- <u>Scout Programs</u>. *All year round 1 hour.* We offer hands-on nature & animal programs that satisfy scout requirements.
- <u>Community Outreach.</u> *All year round–1 hour.* Attention Teachers! Can't come to the Park? Schedule a Ranger to come to your school!
