Saturday, July 6 at 1 PM to 2 PM

Zippy Skippers! – All Ages. Let's explore Cromwell Valley Park's meadows as we look for and learn about these special butterflies along the way. FREE! Registration REQUIRED.

<u>July Adventure Trek</u> – All Ages. Your adventure starts at the Nature Center. Stop by to get started on a self-guided journey, and then return to the Nature Center to pick up your prize. FREE! Registration REQUIRED.

<u>Caterpillar Count!</u> – Ages 8+. Join a Naturalist as we observe trees and leaves up close. Learn about what types of insects and arthropods visit them. What we see and record will help researchers better understand how our changing climate is influencing even the smallest of creatures. FREE! Registration REQUIRED.

Ochre: Humanity's Paint – Ages 6+. Learn the ancient history of red ochre pigments used around the world. Take a cool hike in our Minebank Run stream to collect and process the rock into paint.
